Literacy across the term.	<p>Children will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explore 'The Wolves of Willoughby Chase' as a class novel • Use drama and role play to explore a character's feelings • Summarise the main ideas in a text • Create character descriptions using emotive language • Create setting descriptions using a wide range of vocabulary • Plan and write narrative poetry based on 'The Wolves of Willoughby Chase' • Use short film 'The Piano' and scenes from 'Up' to explore film narrative • Plan and create a film narrative • Edit and improve work through self and peer assessment
<p><u>Grammar and Sentence level work</u> <u>Children will focus on:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Expanded noun phrases and commas • Hyphens and brackets (parenthesis) • Perfect tense • A/An • Statements, Questions and Commands • Synonyms and Antonyms 	
Numeracy across the term	<p>Children will learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Identify multiples, factors and prime numbers • Multiply numbers up to 4 digits by a 1 or 2 digit number using formal written methods • Divide numbers up to 4 digits by a 1 digit number using the formal written method • Multiply and divide whole numbers and those involving decimals by 10, 100 and 1000 • Compare and order fractions whose denominators are all multiples of the same number • Identify, name and write equivalent fractions of a given fraction • Double any number between 1 and 1000 and find all corresponding halves • Recognise and use both square and cube numbers • Recognise decimal equivalents of fractions with a denominator of 10, 100 or 1000 <p>Children will continue revising times tables.</p>
