Literacy
across the

Children will:

- Continue looking at narrative poetry using 'The Highwayman' by Alfred Noyes
- Write their own narrative poem about a dragon
- Write a persuasive piece about global issues
- Look at choral and performance poetry

Grammar and Sentence level work

Children will focus on:

- Using extended noun phrases
- Using commas in lists and to clarify meaning
- Identifying and using modal verbs
- Using brackets to add extra information
- Using the 'perfect' tense
- Revising when to use 'a' or 'an'
- Revising the difference between a statement, question and command
- Identifying and using synonyms and antonyms
- Using prepositions

Daily guided reading sessions will continue throughout the half term.

Numeracy
across the
term

Children will:

- Read and write Roman Numerals to 100
- Recognise multiples, primes and factors
- Multiply numbers with up to 4 digits by a 1 or 2 digit number using formal written methods
- Divide up to 4 digits by a 1 digit number using formal written methods
- Multiply and divide whole numbers by 10, 100 and 1000 (including decimals)
- Compare and order fractions whose denominators are all multiples of the same number
- Recognise equivalent fractions
- Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator and denominators that are multiples of the same number

Children will continue revising times tables.
