Children will:

- Study the novel 'The Snow-Walker's Son' and answer comprehension questions about it
- Write their own legend based on the story Beowulf
- Revise and write a set of instructions

Daily guided reading sessions will continue throughout the half term.

Grammar and Sentence level work

Children will focus on:

- Determiners and pronouns
- Expanded noun phrases
- Basic punctuation (question marks, full stops etc)
- Connectives and conjunctions
- Fronted adverbials
- Modal verbs and prepositions
- Suffixes and prefixes
- Word families
- Clauses and parenthesis

Numeracy
across the
term

Children will learn to:

- Read, write, order and compare numbers to at least 1,000,000 and determine the value of each digit
- Round any number up to 1,000,000 to the nearest 10, 100, 1000, 10000, 100000
- Use the correct method for column addition and subtraction
- Identify roman numerals
- Work with negative numbers
- Add and subtract with decimals
- Solve addition and subtraction multi-step problems

Children will continue revising times tables.
