

## Year 3 Curriculum Plan: Spring 2 Term

### What makes the world angry?

6 weeks

Literacy

**Children will:**

- Create shape poems about different flowers and plants.
- Read the story of 'Jack and the Beanstalk'. Children will retell and create their own adventure story.
- Create information texts comparing living in England and Japan based on volcanic activity.

**Grammar and Sentence level work**

**Children will focus on:**

- Including adverbs in writing to add detail.
- Using speech marks correctly.
- Using apostrophes to show contraction such as in *didn't, don't, can't* etc.
- Including a range of conjunctions in their writing such as *because, when, although, if*.
- Use prefixes and suffixes.
- Use plural apostrophes for possession.
- Use statements, rhetorical questions and commands in their writing.
- Look at different word classes
- Use 'a' and 'an' correctly in their writing.

**Daily guided reading sessions and weekly phonics sessions will continue throughout the term.**

Numeracy  
across the  
term

- Tell and write the time from an analogue clock including Roman numerals and 12/24 hour.
- Estimate and read time with increasing accuracy to the nearest minute.
- Know the number of seconds in a minute, days in each month year and leap year.
- Compare the duration of events to calculate the time taken to particular events or tasks.
- Draw 2d shapes investigating different lines and angles.
- Order angles from biggest to smallest and know the names of different angles
- Investigating 2d and 3d shapes knowing each of the correct name and properties.
- Use the inverse to work out addition and subtraction and multiplication and division facts.
