Reading

- Daily reciprocal reading
- Read all high frequency words
- Practice asking questions, predicting, clarifying and summarizing- to improve understanding of what has been read.
- Inference skills-'reading between the lines'
- Comprehension based activities

Spelling, punctuation and grammar

- Term 3 spellings from spelling toolkit
- Continuation of high frequency words for LA
- Continue taking words from the year 4 statutory word list
- Extending sentences with more than one clause
- Using a wider range of conjunctions
- Present perfect tense
- Choosing appropriate nouns or pronouns for clarity
- Conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions to express time and cause
- Fronted adverbials including the use of the comma after the fronted adverbial
- Possessive apostrophe
- Plural nouns
- Formal/informal language
- First person and third person
