Children will:

- Continue exploring film narratives.
- Write a short film narrative for 'Monty the Penguin', the John Lewis advert.
- Writing at a distance: children to revisit a range of writing styles learnt throughout the year independently.

Grammar and Sentence level work

Children will focus on:

- Recognising and using modal verbs (could, should, would etc.).
- Using expanded noun phrases to make their writing more interesting.
- Revise the appropriate use of commas and apostrophes.
- Revise relative and subordinate clauses.

Daily guided reading sessions and comprehension sessions will continue across the half term.

- Identifying, describing and representing the position of a shape following a reflection or translation using the appropriate language, and know that the shape has not changed.
- Revising fractions, decimals and percentages.
- Revising measure, including converting between different units of metric measure.
- Problem solving involving a range of skills learnt throughout the year.
