

Year 2 Curriculum Plan: Summer Term

Why do we love to be beside the seaside?- Summer 1
Can a human grow in soil?- Summer 2

Literacy through topic.

- Plan and write an alternative version of a well-known story.
- Take part in role play activities.
- Plan and write a seaside adventure story.
- Use descriptions and speech to write interesting stories.
- To identify the features of a non-fiction text.
- Use headings, sub-heading & bullet points.
- To write an explanation text.
- Write persuasively.
- Follow and write instructions.

Literacy across the term.

Reading:

- Daily guided reading.
- Continuing to use phonics to decode words.
- Read all high frequency words.
- Practising asking questions to improve understanding of what has been read.
- Inference skills- 'reading between the lines'.
- Answer a range of comprehension style questions.

Spelling, punctuation and grammar:

- Use capitals and full stops; and adjectives to make interesting sentences.
- Use of question marks and exclamation marks.
- Use commas to separate items in a list.
- Use past and present tense when writing sentences.
- Use of prefixes and suffixes.
- Continue to apply phonic knowledge and skills to spell words.

Children will continue to be given spellings to learn at home every week. Children will be given additional support with these spellings at school and will be tested weekly.

	<p><u>Handwriting:</u> Children are expected to be forming all letters correctly, including writing b and d without reversal. Use diagonal strokes to join letters.</p>
<p>Numeracy-</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To understand and use different units of measurement for length, capacity and weight. • Multiplication and division facts for twos, fives, tens and threes. • Investigating times tables. • Understand place value (hundreds, tens and units) in three digit numbers. • Add/ subtract multiples of 10 to a two digit number. • Counting forwards & backwards. • Counting in jumps of 10. • Ordering numbers. • Count both forwards & backwards in steps of 2,3 and 5 from 0 and in tens from a number. • Compare & order numbers. • Read & write numbers. • Use place value to solve problems.
