A Note from our Inclusion Officer, Paula O'Donnell

Ofsted and government targets state that all primary school children should achieve attendance of 97% and above. It is the responsibility of a parent/guardian to provide evidence/a reason for their child/children on a daily basis.

If a reason has not been provided at the end of each school week the absence/s will be unauthorized and coded accordingly.

Any excessive and sporadic unauthorized absence that reaches 90% or below will be referred to the Inclusion Officer for further intervention.

In order for school to make contact in the instance of absence it is vital that all contact numbers and addresses that school hold are up to date. It is a safeguarding concern if a parent/guardian cannot be contacted in the case of an emergency when a child/children may require urgent/emergency assistance.

Please ensure that all details held by school are correct and up to date.
